DEFINITIONS

(As per the Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012)

“body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest” means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest.

“land” excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person to occupy the land or receive income.

“securities” includes shares, debentures, bonds, units of collective investment schemes, and similar instruments.
